## France

Morgans was established in the early nineteenth century. It now carries on the great tradition of selecting each year the best parcels of wine from the particular vintage and presents it under the appellation "Reserve". These reserves have been bottled by Marc Bredif. In the heart of the Loire Valley in France, Domaine Marc Brédif was established in 1893 by Ernest Bredif. Since then the wines from the Domaine have been synonymous with quality and tradition.

**13. Chateauneuf du Pape Jacques Charlet** **2007** **€43.00**  
 Aged partly in wood, this is a typical Chateauneuf du Pape, with good concentrated flavours and a long finish.

**14. Cotes du Rhone Villages, La Berardiere** **2006** **€28.00**  
 A blend of Syrah, Mourvedre, Grenache. Very old vines give great personality and concentration to this wine. Medium bodied, it has terrific perfumes of black cherries and strawberries with a deliciously long after taste. Parker 89/100.

**15. Pinot Blanc Cuvée Les Amours - F.E. Hugel et Fils** **2005** **€29.00**  
 Dry, yet very refreshing, delicate with nice fruit.

**16. Gewurztraminer - F.E. Hugel et Fils** **2006** **€35.00**  
 Full, rich, dry and spicy with a very aromatic flavour.

Loire Valley

**17. Sancerre, Jean Max Roger** **2006** **€45.00**  
 Beautiful aromatic bouquet, with fresh appetising fruit, full and ripe with zippy acidity.

Italy

**18. Chianti Rufina, Villa di Vetrice** **2006** **€29.50**  
 A delicious youthful Chianti packed with ripe, fruity juicy flavours and ideal acidity.

**19. Amarone Costasera Classico, Masi** **2005** **€63.00**  
 Full robust dry wine with a bouquet of black cherries and a long lingering finish.

*Since 1353 the noble Serego Alighieri family, descended from the poet Dante Alighieri, has cultivated its estate in Valpolicella with passion and professionalism.*

**20. Serego Alighieri "Possessioni" Rosso** **2006** **€34.00**  
 Traditional Corvina grapes blend well with the Sangiovese that has always been cultivated on the estate. Brief ageing in cherry wood casks lends unique personality to the wine giving it a spicy, fruity body. Elegant enough to drink throughout the meal.

**21. Serego Alighieri Bianco** **2005** **€29.50**  
 This wine combines the intense bouquet of flowers and fruit of Sauvignon Blanc with the delicate elegance of the Garganega grape, with its characteristic aftertaste of almonds. It is perfect as an aperitif, or with antipasti, pasta, fish, chicken or veal.

	Pinot Grigio "the grape everybody wants to try". The palate is full, rich and dry with a delicate vanilla note on the finish. The flavour is supplemented by a little of the local Verduzzo grape.

	From Bujanda, one of the few producers in Rioja who own all their vineyards, this wine possesses far more fruit and structure than most Riojas and is a wonderful accompaniment to a range of foods. Subtle, well balanced and lightly oaked.		
<b>25.</b>	<b>Marques de Caceres Red, Rioja</b>	<b>2005</b>	<b>€29.50</b>
	This is a beautifully soft fruit driven wine with good structure and a long finish.		
<b>26.</b>	<b>LeAltanza Rioja Reserva</b>	<b>1999</b>	<b>€39.00</b>
	Clean, intense cherry red colour. Offering different and complex aromas, mainly from it's very ripe quality fruit but also from the elegance of it's ageing in mostly new French and American oak.		
<b>27.</b>	<b>Riscal 1860, Tempranillo,</b>	<b>2006</b>	<b>€25.00</b>
	Vino de Mesa de Castilla y Leon. Super soft, fruity, easy drinking red.

	Nice aromas of soft ripe fruits with touches of toast and vanilla. Nice concentration with a long finish. Perfect with pasta, light & creamy cheeses, fish and seafood.

	Has attractive aromas of fresh fruit such as pineapple, grapefruit, lime or peach. Lively on the palate with a clean and fruity finish

	Ruby red in colour with intense aromas of cherries and ripe plums. The palate is soft and well rounded.

### Petit Château

Claret vintages are accorded more importance than those of any other wine. Vintage is crucial because wines age at different rates according to the vintage. Some wines will be better to drink before they are fully mature, because, although their final balance may not be terribly impressive, at least they have a good portion of young fruit. Wines also mature differently according to the quality level of the property.

**Patache d'Aux** **Cru Bourgeois Médoc** **2002** **€48.00**  
A well known Cru Bourgeois from the North Médoc; Ripe with distinct berry character, well structured with good balance and integrated oakiness

**Château Les Ormes-de-Pez** **St Estephe** **2000** **€78.50**  
Well made wine with an excellent finish, good acidity with cranberry and cassis.

**Château Lynch Bages** **Pauillac** **1998** **€227.00**
